The disciples in this weekend's gospel do not ask Jesus to increase their faith, they are telling him to help them grow in faith, they want it deeply. However, we can be direct, and thankful for the response we expect, and even if the answer is no, for the response we get. God is, after all, Our Eternal Father, and loves each of us.
