6. Pope Leo proclaimed a special Jubilee Year in honour of St. Francis of Assisi until Jan 10, 2027. Bishop Gregory has designated our parish as a pilgrimage site. Other parishioners and faithful are invited to make pilgrimage to our parish in this Jubilee Year for receiving plenary indulgence. The conditions for receiving plenary indulgence in this jubilee year are :

- a. **Sacramental Confession** to be in God's grace (in the eight days before or after)
- b. Participation in the Mass and **Eucharistic Communion**
- c. **To visit** in the form of a pilgrimage any Franciscan conventual church or place of worship dedicated to St. Francis of Assisi, where one renews one's profession of faith, through the recitation of the **Creed**, to reaffirm one's Christian identity
- d. The recitation of the **Lord's Prayer**, to reaffirm the dignity of the children of God, received in Baptism
- e. To pray for the **intentions of the Holy Father**, to reaffirm belonging to the Church, whose foundation and visible centre of unity is the Roman Pontiff
